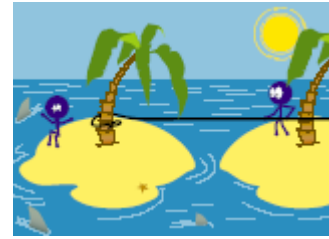
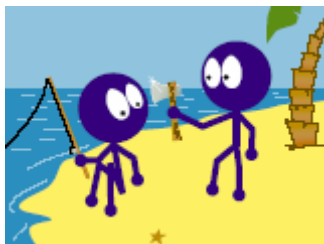




## Script: Far Sighted Client - Rehabilitation
