All application materials, including the scholarship application, two letters of recommendation, and a college transcript, must be completed and returned to the AIG Scholarship for Success Program by April 18, 2008.

Process & Criteria

For purposes of renewal of scholarship awards, recipients must provide an official copy of a current transcript by March 15th of the following year. Students will be notified of their award renewal status. Renewal of internship opportunities will be based upon performance and availability.
